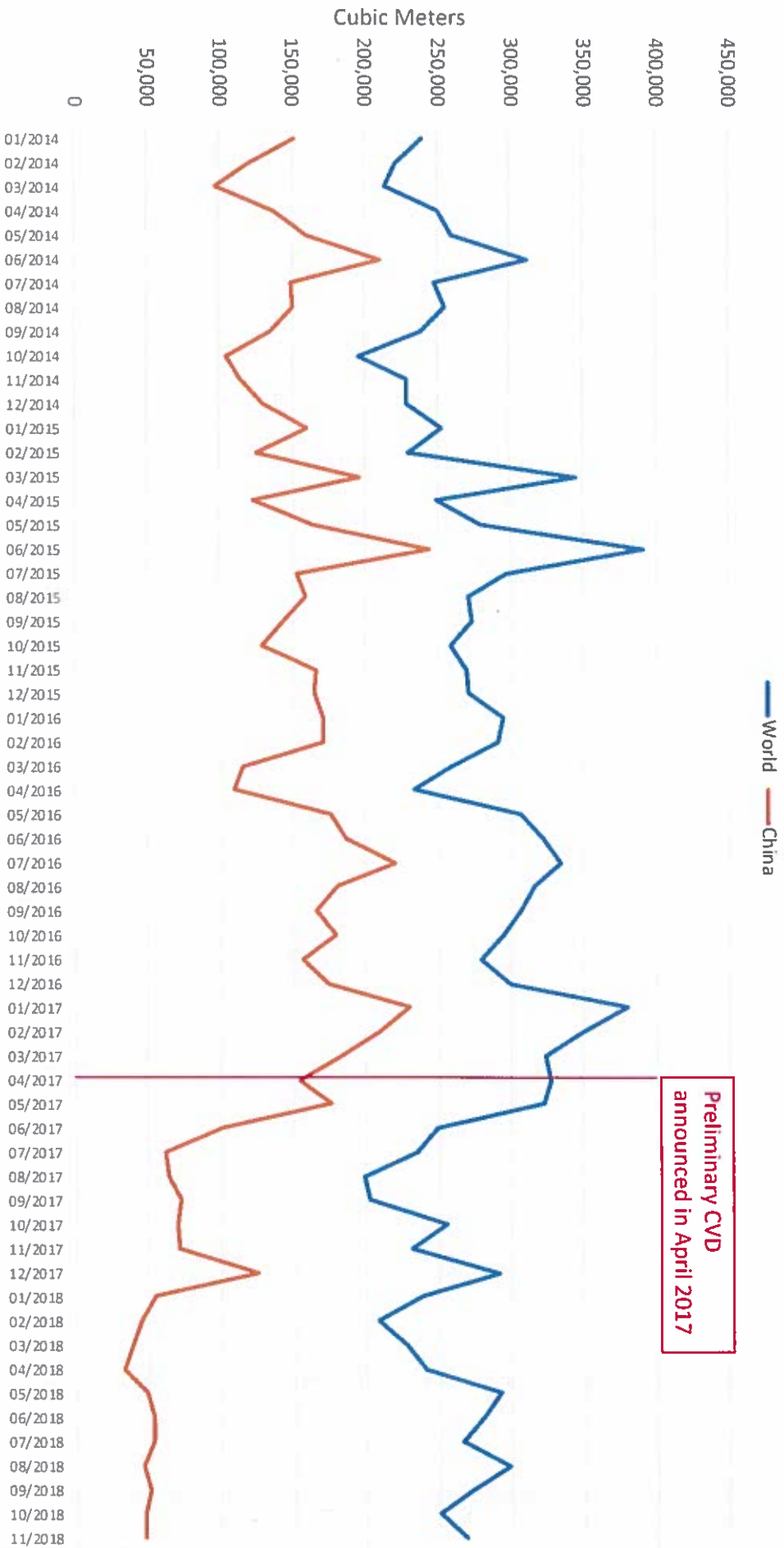
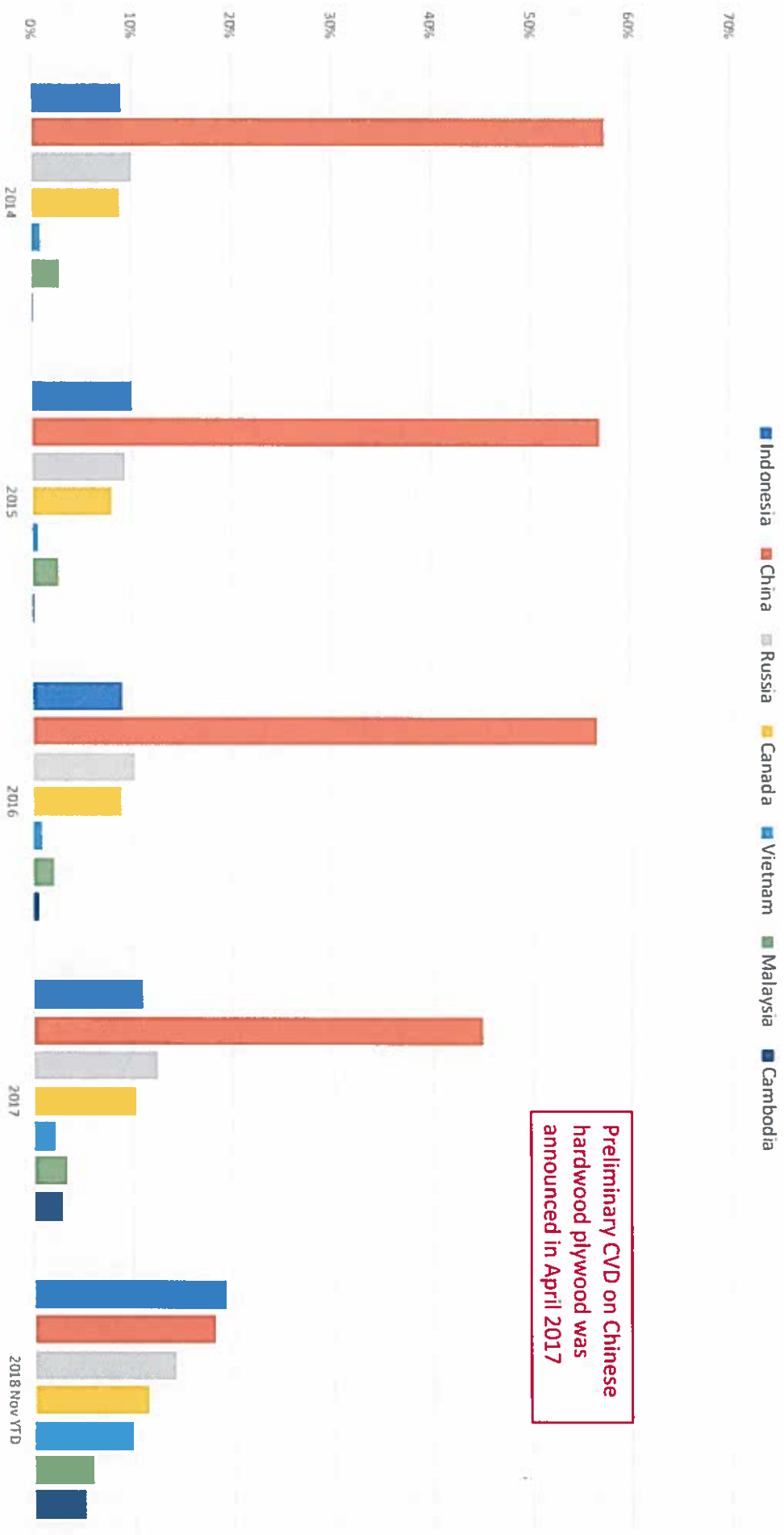


U.S. Imports of Hardwood Plywood

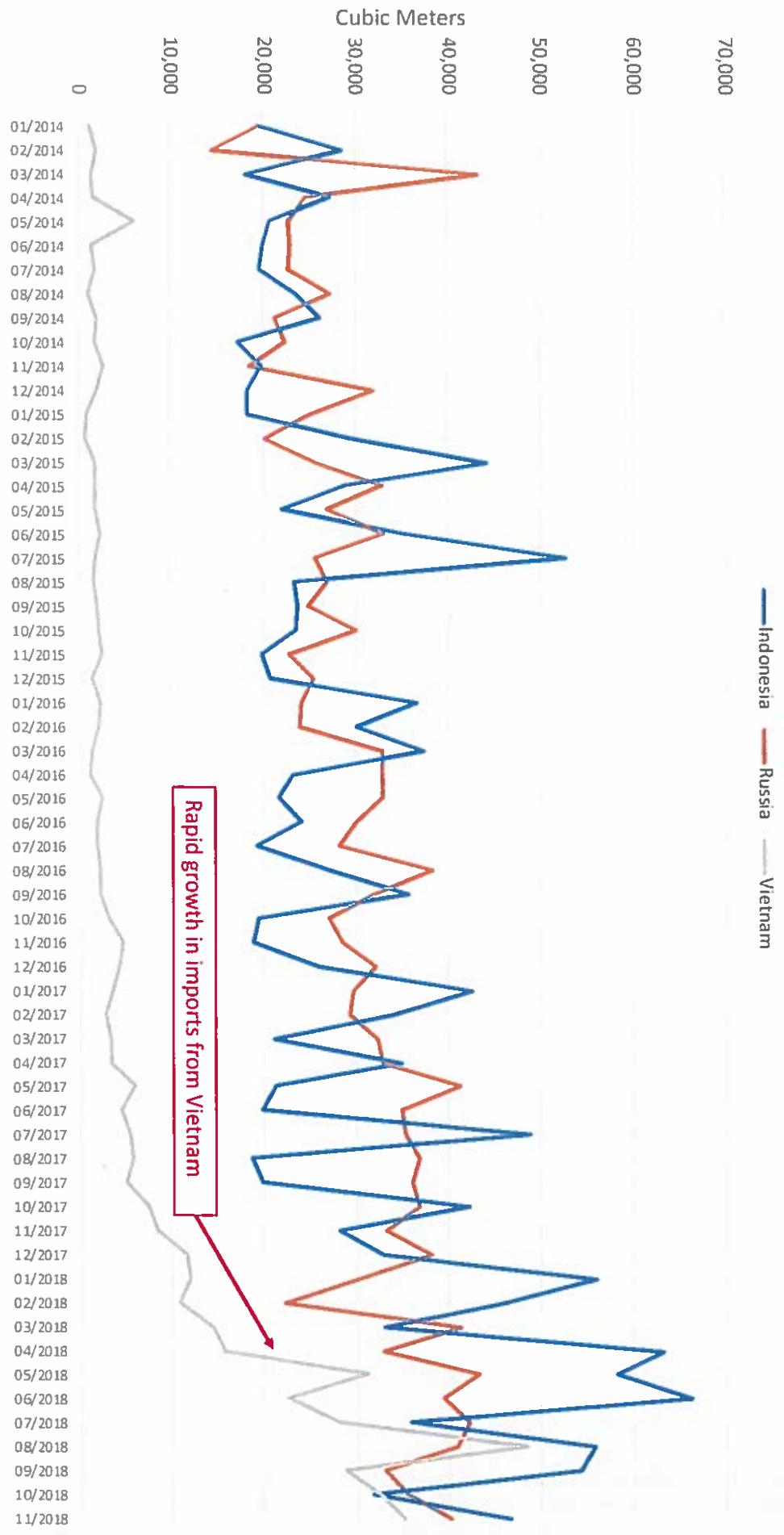
U.S. Hardwood Plywood Imports Sources of Supply



Preliminary CVD on Chinese hardwood plywood was announced in April 2017

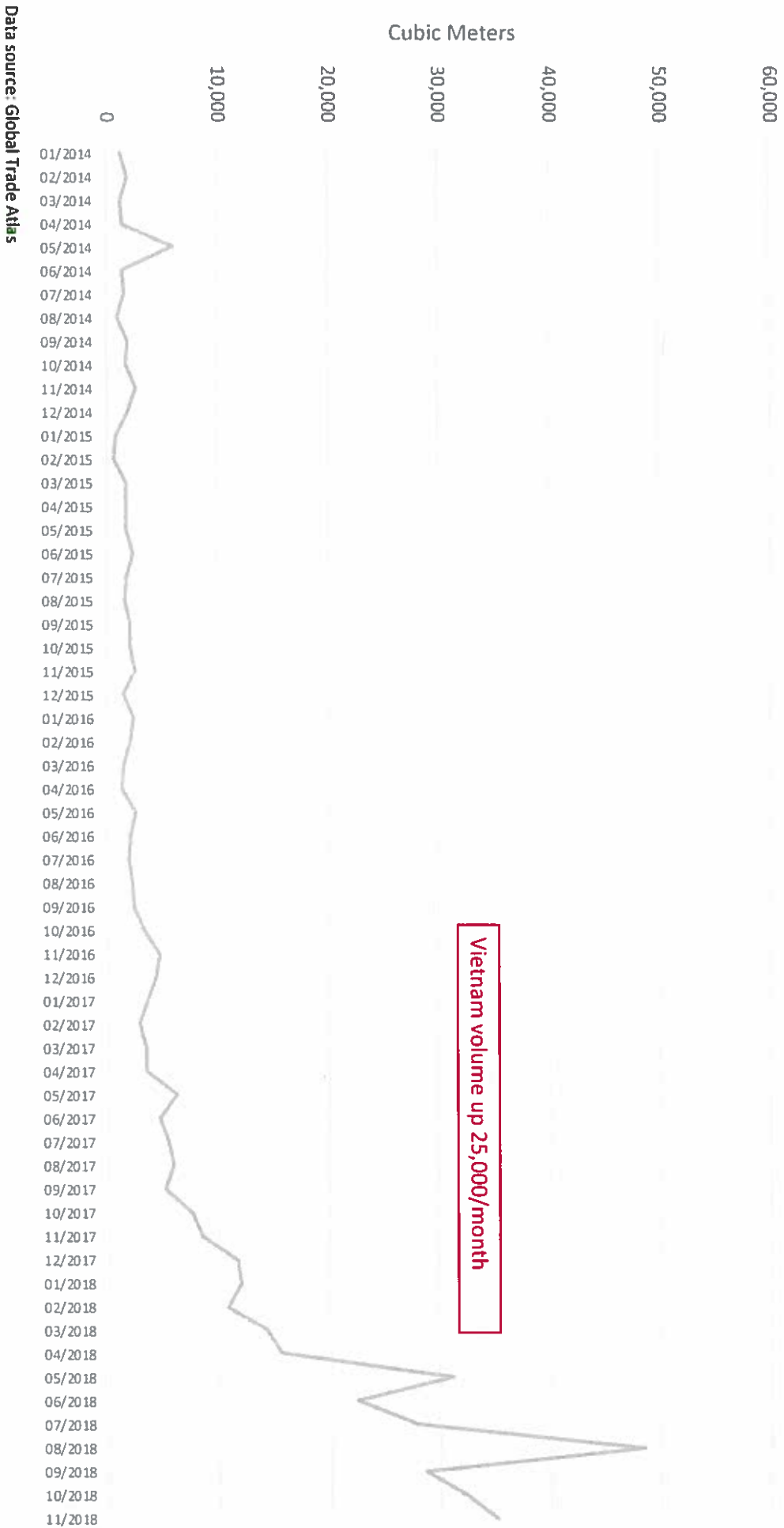

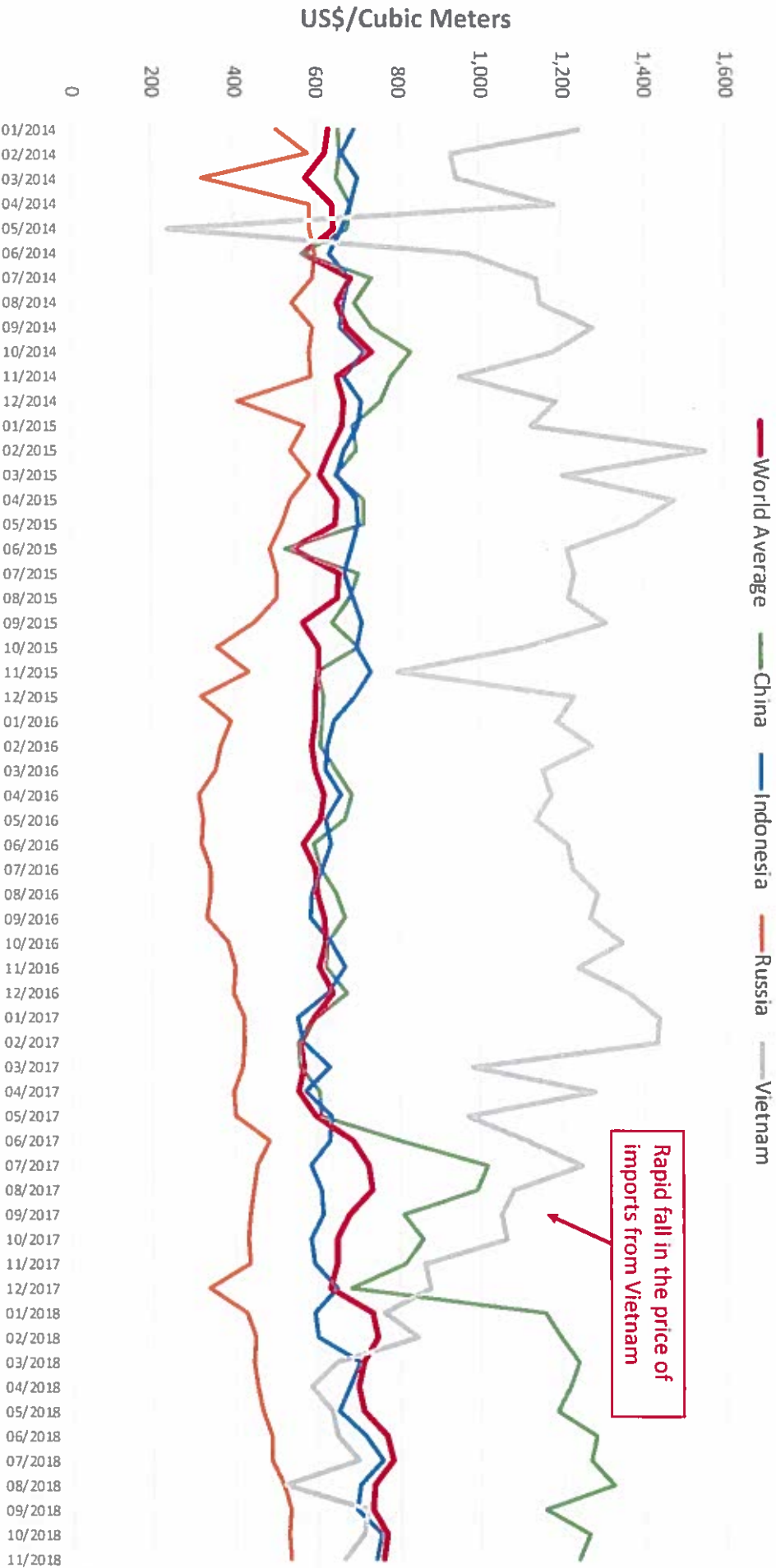

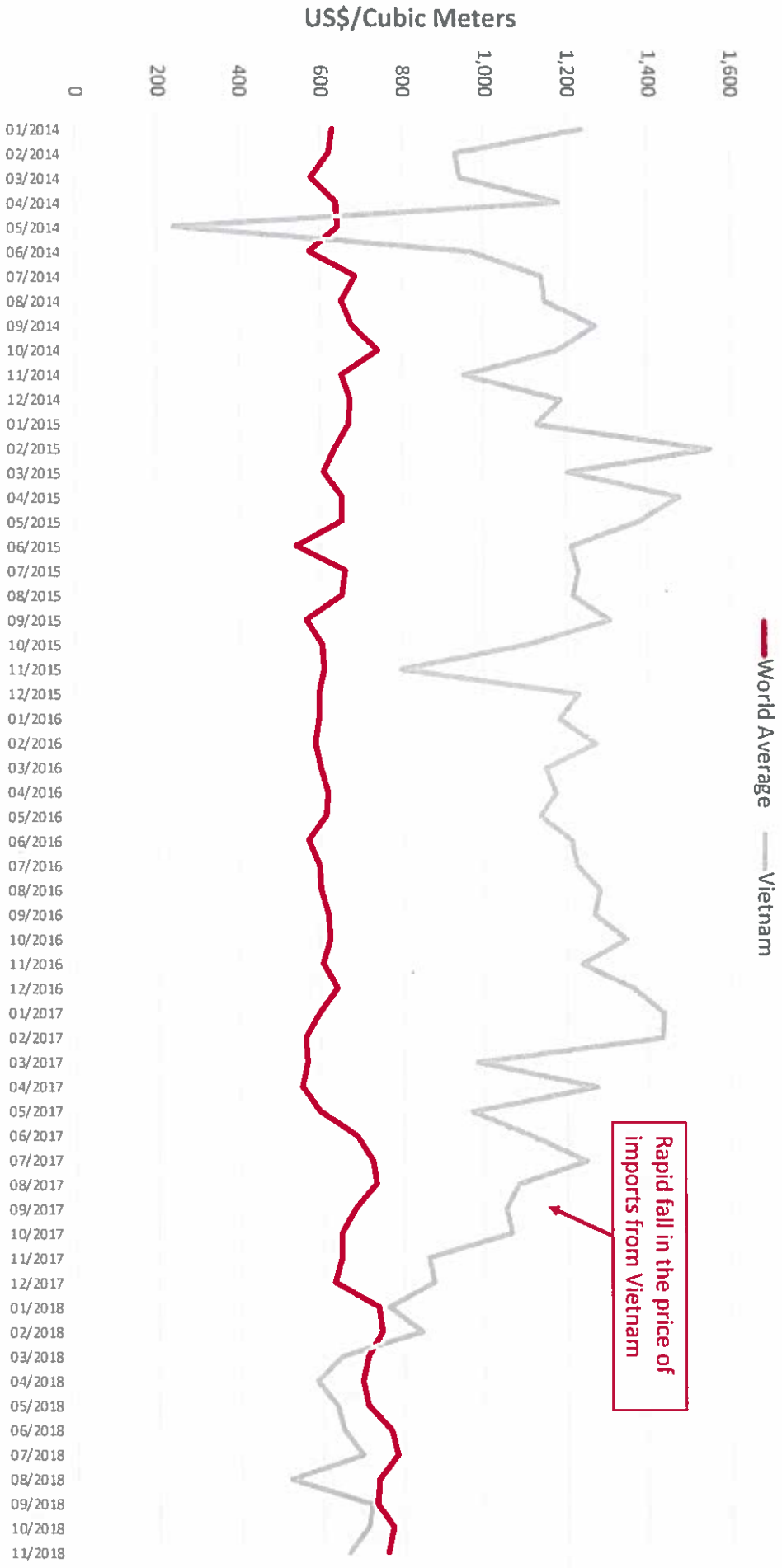
U.S. Imports of Hardwood Plywood: Dollars/Cubic Meter

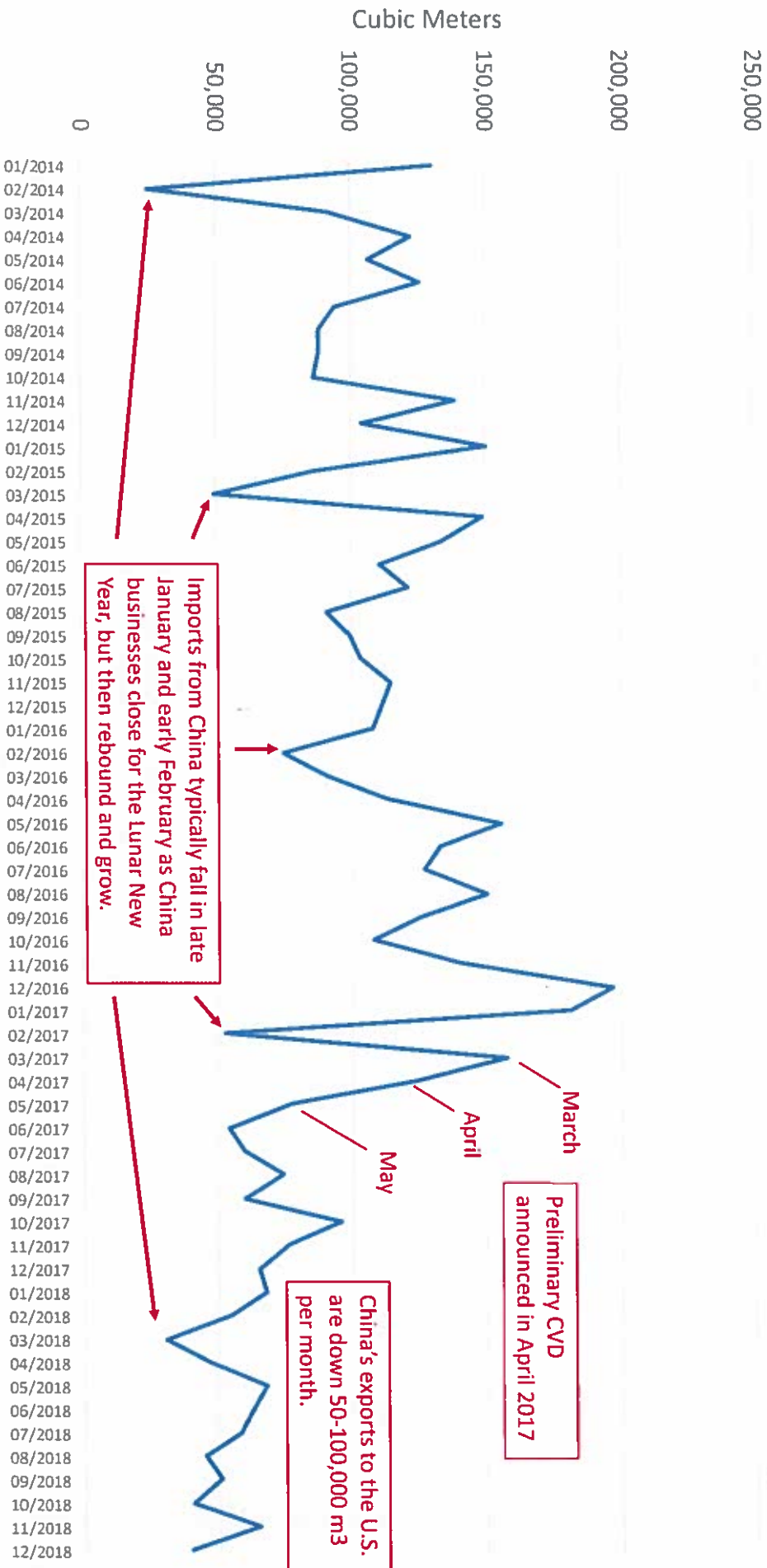

China Exports of Hardwood Plywood to the U.S.



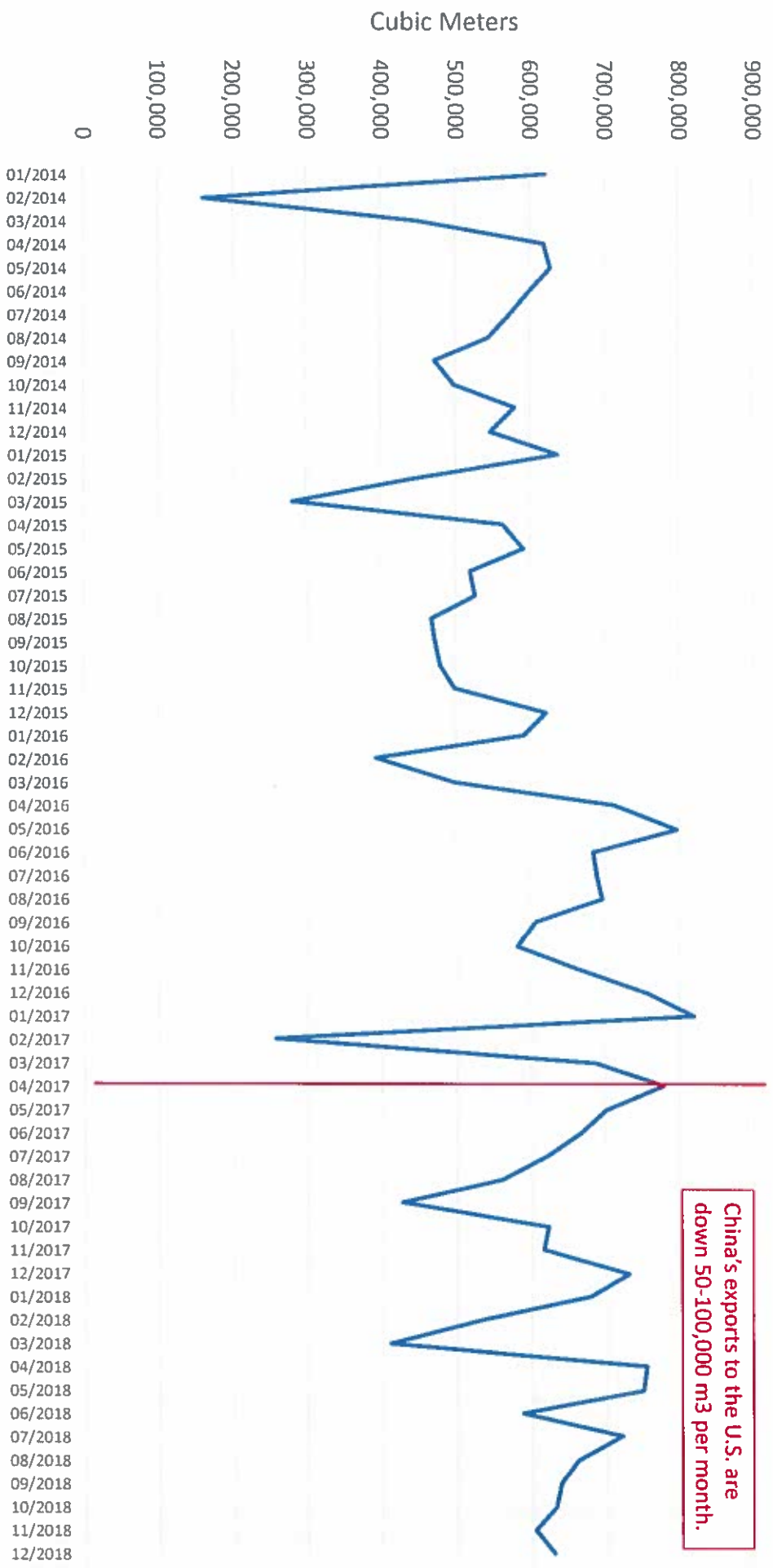
Imports from China typically fall in late January and early February as China businesses close for the Lunar New Year, but then rebound and grow.

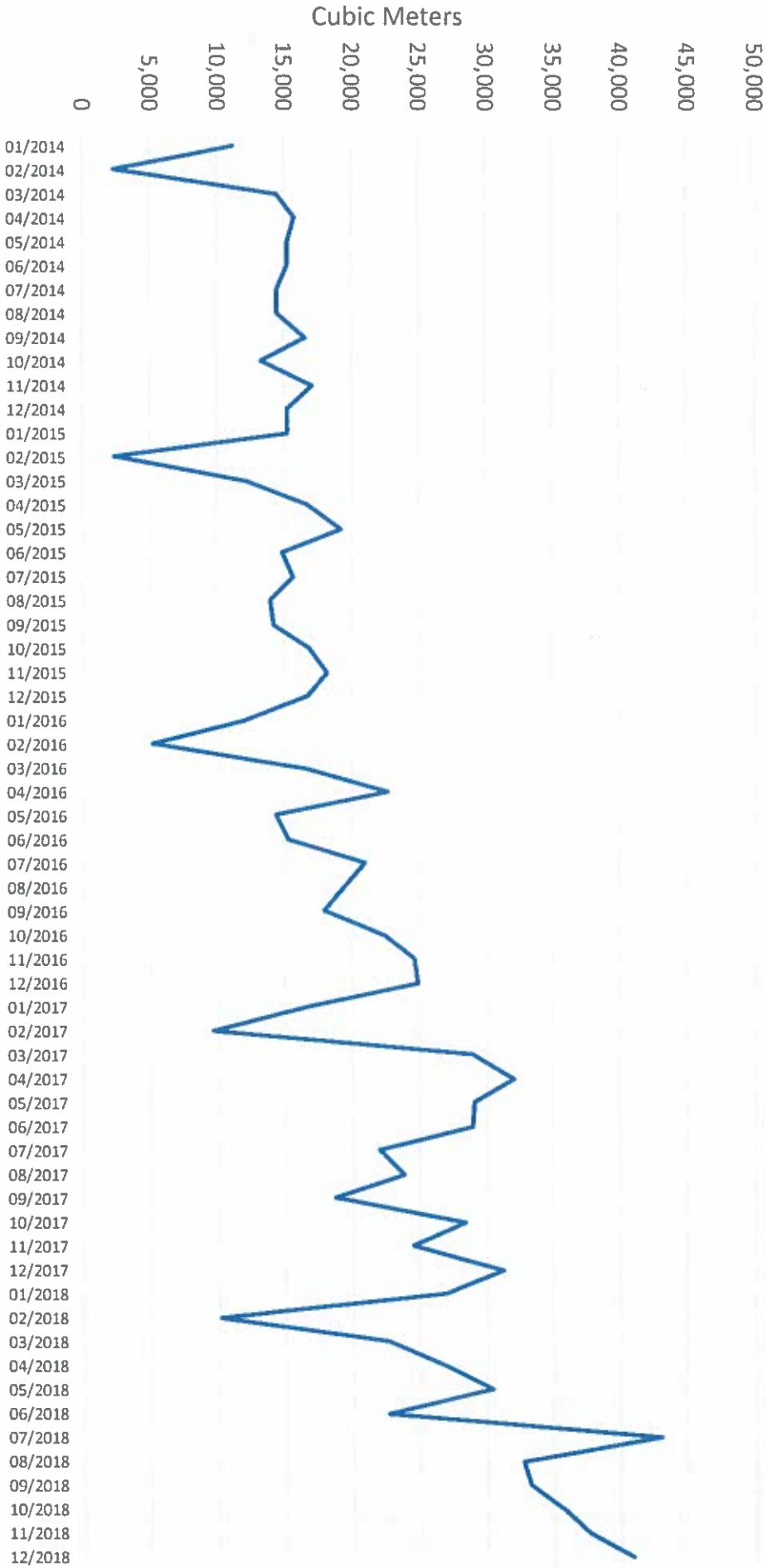
China's Total Exports of Hardwood Plywood
