Our Jack Daniel Distillery tour offers an insight into how the legendary No. 7 is made, as you get to observe each step of the distillery process.

- Start time: 9:00 am
- Please plan to arrive 15 minutes before at 250 Rep. John Lewis Way South (AKA 5th Ave South) outside and near Bob's Steakhouse and Bongo Java Coffee Shop.
- There is limited paid parking in the area, however, we recommend you take an Uber/Lyft or walk to the pickup location.
- You must have a valid ID and be 21 years of age or older. You will not be permitted to do a tasting tour without identification.
- Meeting location: Downtown Nashville at 250 5th Ave South near Bob's Steakhouse
- Tour starts promptly. You will be left behind if you are not on the bus at start time.
- Many distilleries (including Jack Daniel's) do not allow purses and backpacks on tour. Please only bring items that you can fit in your pockets and make sure you have valid ID. Fanny packs and clutch purses are permitted. You may leave bags on the bus if they are deemed to large.
- Tours run rain or shine. Dress for the weather. Much of the tour is outside. Bring an umbrella or poncho. Wear comfortable shoes. It may be hot or cold.
