We write to you on behalf of kitchen cabinet manufacturers and workers in Alabama to express our concern regarding the first administrative review of the antidumping duty order on *Wooden Cabinets, Vanities, and Components Thereof from China* (Case No. A-570-106).

Cabinet manufacturers across America employ over 250,000 workers with good paying jobs. In recent years, cabinet manufacturers have invested millions of dollars in our communities to expand and enhance their manufacturing facilities. As we recover from the pandemic, the health of this key sector in Alabama is crucial to ensure our state continues to rebound economically.

However, in recent years, dumped and subsidized Chinese kitchen cabinet imports have devastated the domestic kitchen cabinet manufacturing sector. Since 2015, imports from China increased by more than 75 percent, compromising American manufacturers' ability to compete on a level playing field and threatening thousands of American jobs. Fortunately, in April 2020, the Department of Commerce issued anti-dumping duties up to 262 percent against China for their unfair trade practices in this sector. These trade remedies have been essential to protect Alabama jobs and allow the industry to fairly compete in the global marketplace again.

On May 6, 2022, the preliminary results of the Department of Commerce's first annual review of the antidumping duty order were published. As members of Alabama's Congressional Delegation, we strongly believe that all our trade remedy laws must be vigorously enforced to protect our constituents and the U.S. cabinet industry from China's continued unfair trade practices.

Therefore, we request that the Department of Commerce give the American Kitchen Cabinet Alliance's submission related to the antidumping duty order on *Wooden Cabinets, Vanities, and Components Thereof from China* (Case No. A-570-106) full and fair consideration. Thank you for your consideration.
